North Myrtle Beach Installs Solar Powered Crosswalk Caution Lights at Shorehaven Drive and Ocean Boulevard

North Myrtle Beach, SC – The City of North Myrtle Beach has installed solar powered caution lights at the pedestrian crosswalk located at Shorehaven Drive and Ocean Boulevard.

South Carolina law requires motorists to come to a full stop when pedestrians are within a crosswalk. Before entering the Shorehaven/Ocean Boulevard crosswalk, pedestrians can activate the new flashing lights by pushing a button located on the light pole. The flashing lights can be seen from a good distance and will help to make oncoming motorists more aware of the crosswalk location.

The City is working to improve the visibility of other pedestrian crosswalks.
