No Dredging December 22-29 While Crews Head Home to Enjoy Christmas with Their Families

North Myrtle Beach, SC – December 20, 2016 – There will be a pause in the dredging of the Cherry Grove canals December 22-29 so that Orion employees can enjoy the holidays with their families. Dredging is projected to resume December 30 or 31.

Some property owners along the canals to be dredged should be on the lookout for a letter from the City advising them that their floating docks may be in the dredge path or close enough to it that they could be impacted by the dredging. Out of an abundance of caution, the City is notifying those dock owners so that they have the opportunity to move their floating docks out of the way.

Because each channel is a bit different, it is challenging to project with any certainty when the dredge will reach a given channel but, generally speaking, the dredge is currently projected to reach Channel “M” around January 6 and Channel “N” around January 13.
