

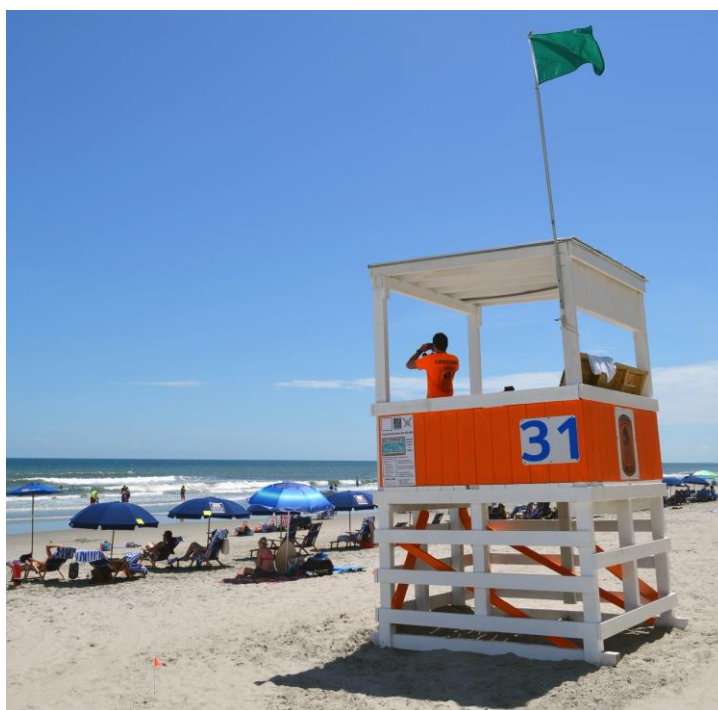

OCEAN LIFEGUARD SAFETY FLAGS

North Myrtle Beach, SC – May 25, 2018 – From time to time you'll see different colored flags flying from the City's ocean lifeguard towers. What do they mean?

- **GREEN** means it's safe to swim.
- **YELLOW** means swim with caution
- **RED** means dangerous conditions, maximum swimming depth knee deep
- **DOUBLE RED** flags mean the beach is closed, no swimming
- **PURPLE** means that dangerous aquatic life has been spotted in the area, ask a lifeguard before entering the water
