**CITY SERVICES REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER 19 AND 20**

*North Myrtle Beach, SC – September 20, 2018 –*

-- City crews collected 90 tons of hurricane debris on September 19 and hauled it to the County landfill.

-- City crews collected 100 tons of hurricane debris on September 20 and hauled it to the County landfill.

-- City crews collected garbage according to the regular schedule on both days.

-- Public Safety personnel continued to participate in high water rescues in South and North Carolina as needed, and provided backup services as requested. These assists do not impact Police or Fire/Rescue coverage of North Myrtle Beach itself.



-- City business license inspectors continued to monitor the city looking for unlicensed contractors and businesses, locating about 40 without licenses. They either now have a city business license or they are gone.

-- City staff have completed a citywide damage assessment and have submitted the report in for administrative review.

-- The City continues to participate in Horry County Emergency Operations Center conference calls.
