## **U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS LEADERS VISIT NORTH MYRTLE BEACH**

*North Myrtle Beach, SC – September 19, 2018* – Brigadier General **Diana M. Holland**, Commander of the South Atlantic Division of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and Lt. Col. **Jeffrey Palazzini**, Commander and 87th District Engineer of the Charleston District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, came to North Myrtle Beach on Wednesday, September 19 to visit with Mayor **Marilyn Hatley** and City Manager **Mike Mahaney** to see firsthand how our 9 miles of beach fared during Hurricane Florence.



U.S. Army Corps of Engineers personnel were also on the beach in North Myrtle Beach running lidar—taking 3D measurements of the beach profile to determine how much sand was lost during Hurricane Florence. The 3D measurements taken will be compared to pre-storm measurements.
