Free Motorcycle Collision Avoidance Training Seminar

North Myrtle Beach, SC – February 5, 2018 – The North Myrtle Beach Public Safety Department is offering a free Motorcycle Collision Avoidance Training Seminar for motorcycle riders who have basic riding knowledge and can operate their motorcycles on the roadway with little to no trouble.

The goal of the seminar is to improve each rider's ability in order to reduce the potential for injuries and motorcycle collisions.

The seminar introduces riders to five basic riding techniques, riding in confined areas, proper braking techniques, evasive maneuvers, and other collision-avoidance related exercises.



The seminar begins with a short classroom session, and then moves to the North Myrtle Beach Drag Strip to practice safe riding techniques while driving.

Motorcycle instructors Sgt. Ray Pollock and L.Cpl. Chris Shick are Institute of Police Technology & Management police motorcycle instructors and have spent over nine years working as police motor officers.

Water will be available throughout the day and lunch will be provided free of charge to all riders.

2018 Seminar Schedule

Note: Each day is a separate seminar. However, you can attend more than one seminar to repeat instruction and they will add things as needed to keep everyone challenged. If you do repeat the seminar, you will get a certificate for each seminar you attend. Each seminar is limited to a maximum of 25 students. No prerequisite course is required.

Each seminar begins at 8:00 a.m. in a classroom at the J. Bryan Floyd Community Center, 1015 Possum Trot Road, NMB, SC 29582 and then proceeds to the riding location, which is the North Myrtle Beach Drag Strip, 2003 Star Bluff Road, Longs, SC 29568.

- Comfortable riding pants
- Long sleeve shirt
- Riding gloves
