NORTH MYRTLE BEACH CITY HALL OPEN SEPTEMBER 11 AND 12

North Myrtle Beach, SC – September 10, 2018 – We urge North Myrtle Beach residents and visitors to follow Governor McMaster's evacuation order effective at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 11.

In order to continue to serve you until you have evacuated, North Myrtle Beach City Hall will be open September 11 and September 12.

Regular sanitation collection will occur as scheduled September 11 and September 12.

The Aquatic & Fitness Center will observe normal hours on September 11, and it will close at 6pm on September 12.

The North Myrtle Beach 9/11 Candlelight observance at Horseshoe has been cancelled.

All Horry County schools are closed September 11 through September 13.

The City's Emergency Operations Center has been up and running and on Wednesday will advance to a 24-hour operation until after the impacts of Hurricane Florence have been successfully dealt with.

Please continue to monitor Hurricane Florence. It is a Category 4 hurricane and could strengthen further as it takes a current path toward the SC/NC coast. Very high winds, significant storm surge and possibly very high amounts of rainfall are of great concern with this storm. It may also take its time moving through the areas where it makes landfall, adding to negative impacts.
