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**November 20 is the last day for suspension of building permit fees for repair work related to Hurricane Florence**

*North Myrtle Beach, SC – November 6, 2018* – If you are a North Myrtle Beach property owner with damage related to Hurricane Florence, but you have not yet applied to the City for a building permit to repair the damage, now is the time to do it.

Since the hurricane, the City of North Myrtle Beach has not charged building permit fees associated with repair work related to damage from Hurricane Florence, however, that will come to an end with the close of business (5:00 pm) on November 20. After that date, building permit fees are charged.
