A RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MYRTLE BEACH TO INCREASE THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE NORTH MYRTLE BEACH MUNICIPAL JUDGE, DEAN MUREDDU, TO ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000.00) FROM JUDGE MUREDDU'S ANNUAL SALARY OF ONE HUNDRED FOUR THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-TWO CENTS (\$104,482.82) SET AT HIS APPOINTMENT IN 2022.

WHEREAS, Judge Dean Mureddu was reappointed as the North Myrtle Beach Municipal Judge on February 7, 2022, by the North Myrtle Beach City Council for a four (4) year term and his compensation was set at One Hundred Four Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Two Dollars and Eighty-Two Cents (\$104,482.82) per year subject to an increase per periodic review by City Council; and

WHEREAS, the North Myrtle Beach City Council met with Judge Mureddu in Executive Session for a periodic performance review on August 18, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF NORTH MYRTLE BEACH, SOUTH CAROLINA:

Section 1: The annual salary for the North Myrtle Beach Municipal Judge, Dean Mureddu, shall be increased to One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00).

Section 2: The increase in salary shall be retroactive to August 18, 2025.

Section 3: The Resolution shall become effective upon the date of passage.
