

Since October 1st, 2025, the City of North Myrtle Beach has received approved grant payments in the amount of \$8,220,514.71.

Façade Grants

Purpose: This program is designed to provide financial partnership opportunities with the City of North Myrtle Beach to perform façade improvements to commercial structures within the City's Activity Center Corridors.

(The building for which the work is proposed must front or face either Sea Mountain Highway, Main Street, 17th Avenue South, or 37th Avenue South, where such road portions are contained within the Priority Investment Activity Center Corridors. This grant has a dollar-for-dollar match requirement)

Since November 18th, 2024, a total of \$77,074.01 has been awarded to the City of North Myrtle Beach for DEA Forfeitures & Seizures.
