1. ROLL CALL:

Mayor Hatley called the meeting to order and asked the Clerk to call the roll.

2. MINUTES:

The motion to approve the minutes for the City Council Meeting of Monday, October 18, 2021, as presented, was made by Councilwoman Fontana and seconded by Councilman Baldwin. The motion to approve passed 7-0.

3. COMMUNICATIONS:

Mayor Hatley presented a Proclamation highlighting December 3, 2021 as Arbor Day in the City of North Myrtle Beach. A representative from the SC Forestry Commission presented the Tree Board and the City with the Tree City USA Award. This marked the 16th year the City has received the award.

Mayor Hatley read the ordinance by title and Mayor Hatley called for a motion. Councilwoman Fontana motioned to approve and was seconded by Councilman Thomas.
