Background:

Section 14-25-15 of the South Carolina Code of Laws provides “Each municipal judge must be appointed by the council to serve for a term set by the council of not less than two years but no more than four years and until his successor is appointed and qualified. His compensation must be fixed by the council.”

The attached Resolution would reappoint Dean Mureddu for a four (4) year term as the North Myrtle Beach Municipal Judge. The compensation for the position will be \$104,482.82 per year subject to an increase per periodic review by Council in addition to receiving employee benefits conferred upon other city employees.

**A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT DEAN MUREDDU, ESQUIRE,
AS THE MUNICIPAL JUDGE FOR THE CITY OF NORTH
MYRTLE BEACH FOR A TERM OF FOUR YEARS**

WHEREAS, the position of the Municipal Judge has been classified as full time;

WHEREAS, Attorney Dean Mureddu has agreed to be reappointed as the North Myrtle Beach Municipal Judge.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF NORTH MYRTLE BEACH, SOUTH CAROLINA:

Section 1: Dean Nicholas Mureddu, Esquire, is hereby appointed as the North Myrtle Beach Municipal Judge for a period of four (4) years beginning on February 7, 2022.

Section 2: The compensation for this position shall be \$104,482.82 per year subject to an increase per periodic review by City Council in addition to employee benefits conferred upon the other employees of the City.

Section 3: This resolution shall be effective upon the date of passage.
