Mayor Hatley stated the purpose of the meeting was to declare a State of Emergency pertaining to Hurricane Ian. Mayor Hatley called for a motion to approve the emergency ordinance declaring that a localized State of Emergency existed within the City of North Myrtle Beach and authorizing the appropriate action to be taken in connection therewith. Councilman Collins motioned to approve and was seconded by Councilwoman Fontana. Mayor Hatley stated this would help the city in preparation for the storm. Mayor Hatley called for a vote. The motion passed 6-0.

Councilman Collins stated he was glad the city was getting out ahead of the storm and being proactive in preparing the city. Mayor Hatley agreed and stated the city was working very hard to prepare for the storm in conjunction with the Emergency Operations Center, Public Safety, and our Public Information Officer, Donald Graham. She stated they would continue to keep the public informed throughout this emergency.

Mayor Hatley called for a motion to declare a State of Emergency for North Myrtle Beach. Councilman Collins motioned to approve and was seconded by Councilwoman Fontana. The motion passed 6-0.

Mayor Hatley adjourned the meeting at 3:03 PM.
