Background:

To help cover incurred costs and stay competitive with the rates of surrounding municipalities, staff recommends an adjustment to the current parking rates.

Staff is requesting that council authorize and adopt an adjustment to the parking fee in city-owned public parking lots and rights-of-way from \$2 per hour to \$3 per hour except for the Seaview Lot. The Seaview Lot is a “value lot” so staff is requesting an adjustment from \$1 per hour to \$2 per hour for this lot only.

ORDINANCE

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADJUST PARKING FEES IN
CITY-OWNED PUBLIC PARKING LOTS AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF NORTH MYRTLE BEACH, SOUTH CAROLINA,
IN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT**

Section 1. There is authorized and adopted an adjustment to the parking fee in city-owned public parking lots and rights-of-way from \$2 per hour to \$3 per hour except for the Seaview Value Lot where the adjustment shall be from \$1 per hour to \$2 per hour.

Section 2. The above allocation shall be effective in accordance with accounting practices utilized by the City in the administration of General Fund monies.

Section 3. This ordinance becomes effective on the date of passage and supersedes any inconsistent ordinance(s).
